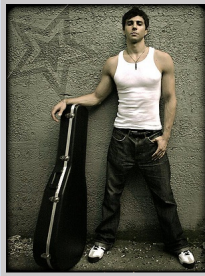


Front Row Fanz - Article on David Homyk
